Habitat: the place where a plant or animal normally lives or grows.

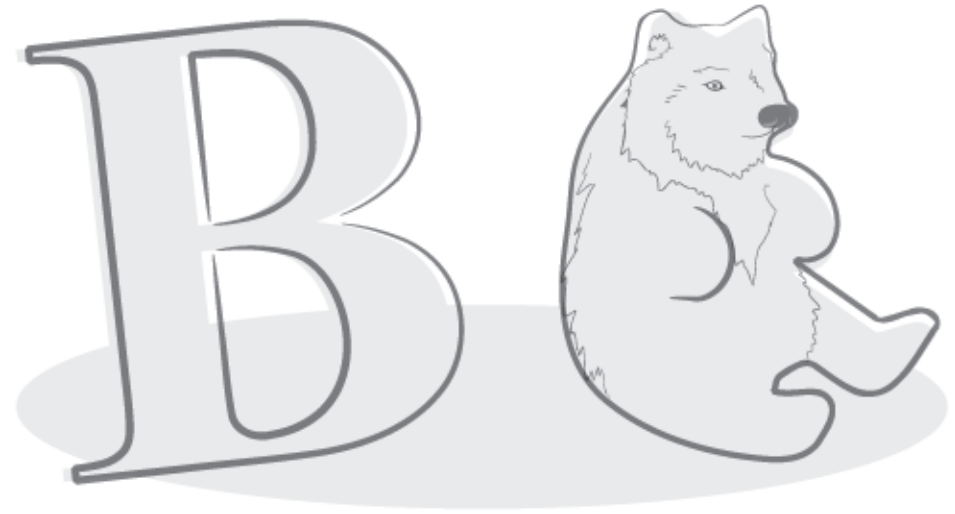
ELEPHANTS

- treat animals with respect



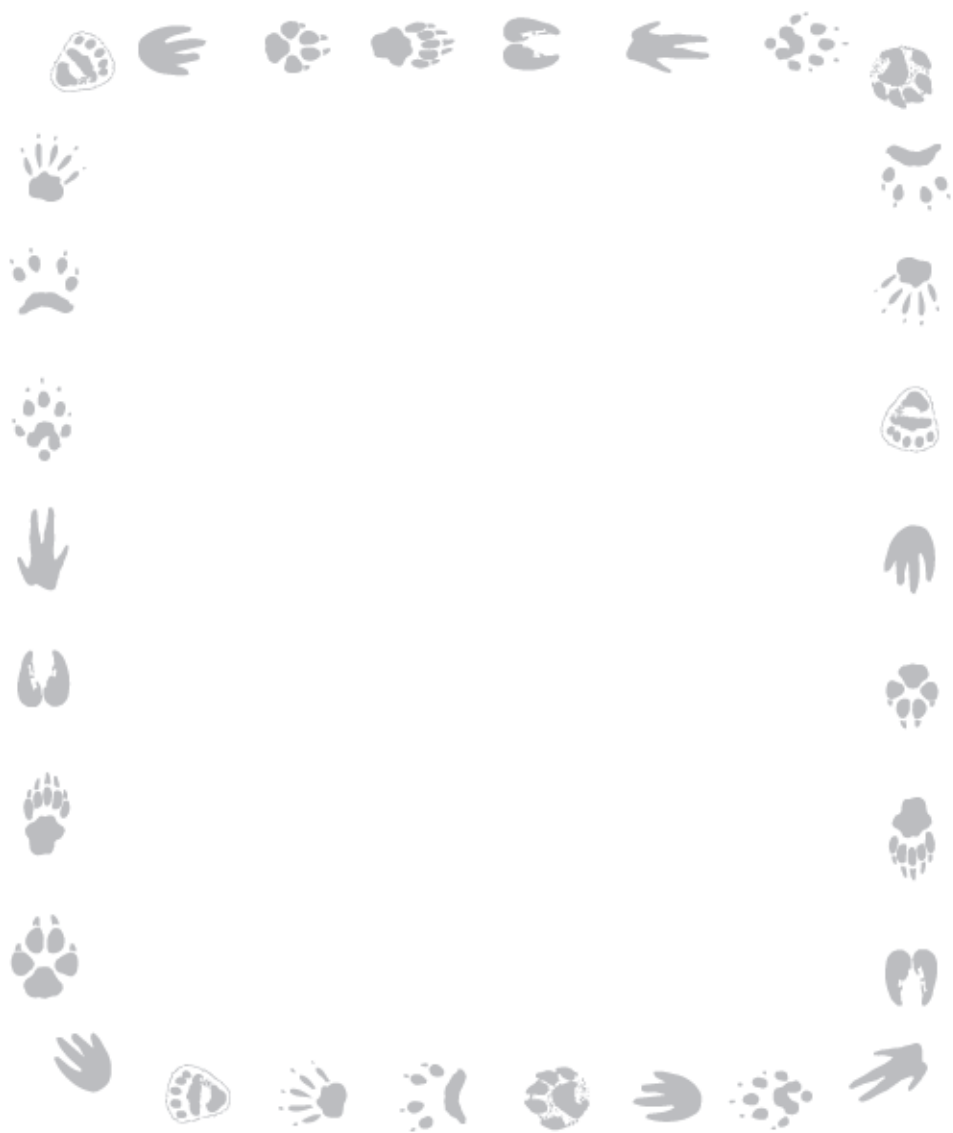
