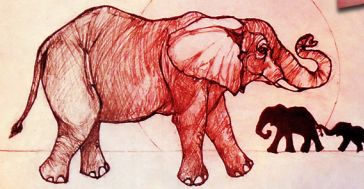


Padded Feet

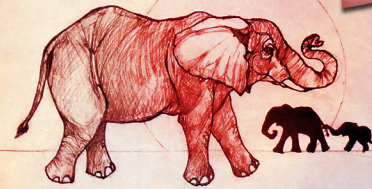


Fertilize

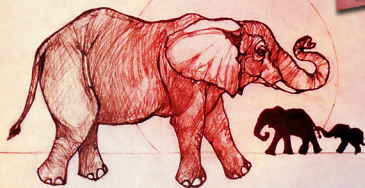


Sensors

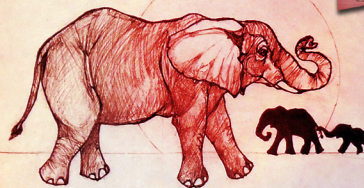


Info quake

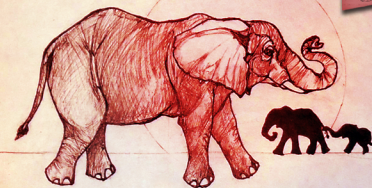


Infrasounds
